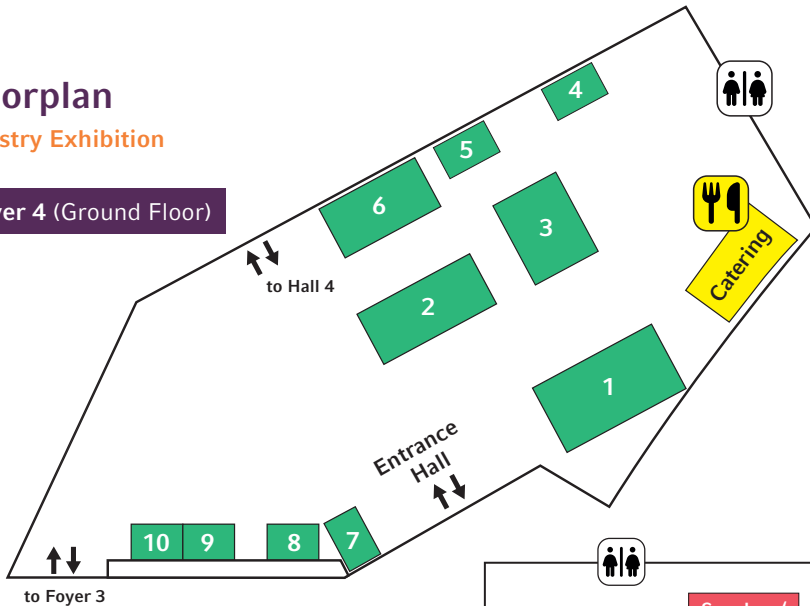

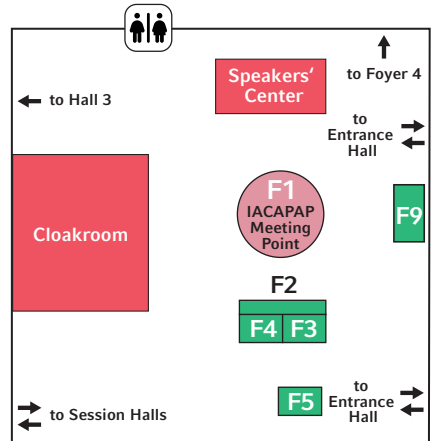

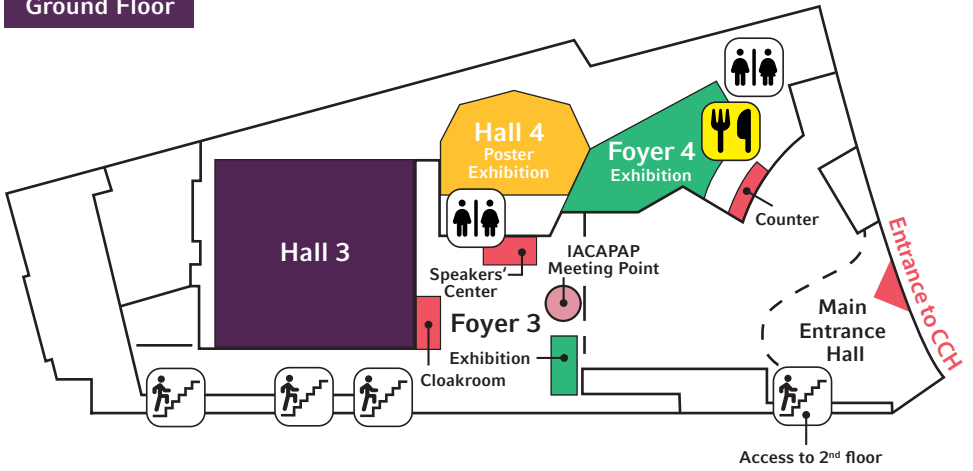

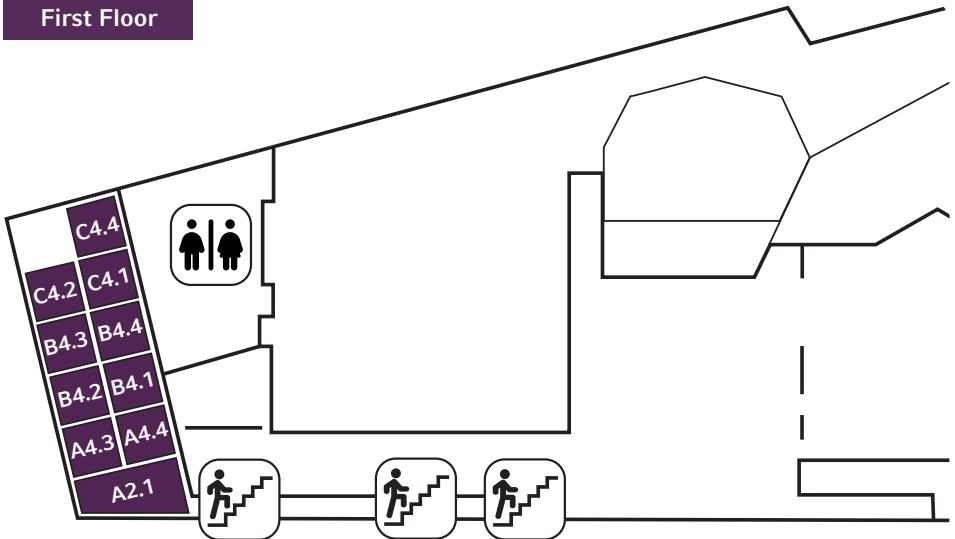

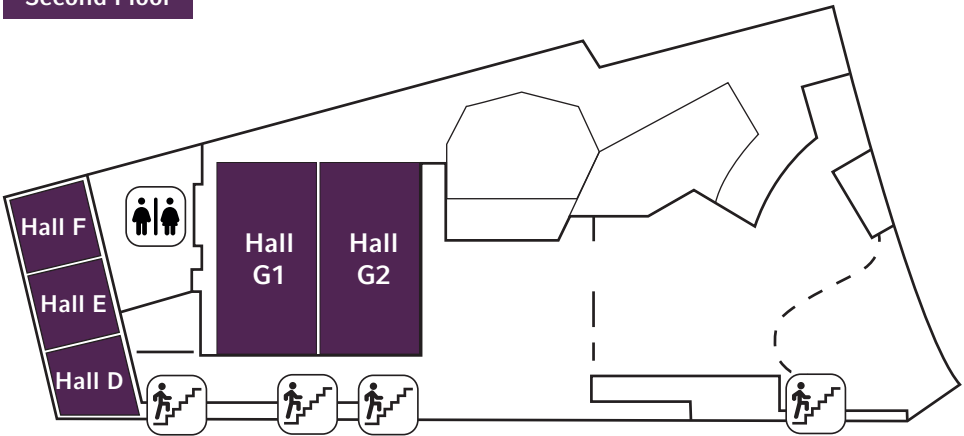
First Floor
